

## **SMWC Music Therapy Practicum Sites may include:**

### ***Behavioral Health/Psychiatric Care/Correctional***

#### **CODA (Council on Domestic Abuse)**

*Student serves adults or minors who are victims of domestic violence and sexual abuse.*

#### **Hamilton Center, In-Patient Behavioral Psychiatric Unit**

*Student serves adolescents and adults struggling with stress, life changes, relationship issues, depression, anxiety disorders, serious mental illnesses, and/or drug and alcohol dependence.*

#### **Booker T. Washington Alternative High School**

*Student serves pregnant, parenting, and alternative students who have either dropped out of school or who cannot cope with the standard school system.*

#### **Regional Hospital, Mehta Behavioral Health Unit**

*Student serves patients in an acute care center providing treatment for adults with a wide range of mental health concerns.*

#### **Vigo County Juvenile Detention Center**

*Student serves adolescents who are awaiting trial in Juvenile Court or enrolled in Juvenile Probation or Juvenile Detention.*

### ***Intellectual & Developmental Disabilities***

#### **Bridges of Indiana, Inc.**

*Student serves individuals with a variety of developmental and intellectual disabilities in a 1:1 format with an onsite MT-BC.*

#### **Developmental Services, Inc.**

*Student serves adults with a variety of mild to moderate developmental and intellectual disabilities with an onsite MT-BC.*

#### **Human Resources Center of Edgar & Clark Counties, Rehabilitation Services**

*Student serves adults with a variety of mild to moderate developmental and intellectual disabilities.*

#### **Normal Life/ResCare**

*Student serves either male or female adults with a variety of mild to moderate developmental and intellectual disabilities who live in group homes.*

#### **RT Solutions, Inc., Happiness Bag**

*Student serves adults with a variety of mild to moderate developmental and intellectual disabilities in a day-facility focused on meaningful recreation with an onsite MT-BC.*

## ***Older Adults***

### **Bethesda Gardens, Memory Care Unit**

*Student serves individuals and groups of older adults with mild to moderate dementia who live in an assisted-living facility.*

### **Providence Healthcare Center, General Care Unit & Memory Care Unit**

*Student serves individuals and groups of older adults (many who are Sisters of Providence) with a variety of health concerns who receive continual care.*

## ***Hospice***

### **Hospice of the Wabash Valley**

*Student serves individuals with a variety of health issues who are nearing end-of-life. MTS may also work with family members as appropriate.*

## ***Medical/Rehabilitation***

### **Hux Oncology Unit**

*Student serves individuals who are coping with hospitalization and various stages of cancer treatment with onsite MT-BC/Faculty.*

## ***Early Intervention/Special Education***

### **Davis Park Elementary School**

*Student works with a classroom of children with various intellectual and developmental disabilities, or with individual students who have speech and/or language difficulties. Opportunity to work collaboratively with a speech language pathologist in individual settings, as well as traditional classroom settings.*

### **Lost Creek Elementary School**

*Student works with young children including those at academic risk, those with anger management issues, and/or a variety of intellectual, developmental, and learning disabilities.*

### **Sugar Grove Elementary School**

*Student works with young children on the Autism Spectrum and with a variety of other intellectual or developmental disabilities, and/or with speech or hearing impairments.*

### **Terre Town Elementary School**

*Student works with a classroom of children with various intellectual and developmental disabilities.*
