Basic Competency Requirements accepted for Formal Enrollment (Gateway I) to the SMWC Educator Preparation Program by one of the following prior to July 1, 2018:

- Indiana Core Academic Skills Assessment (CASA)
 - Reading (Test 001): cut score 220
 - Mathematics (Test 002): cut score 220
 - Writing: (Test 003): cut score 220
- ACT (Math, Reading, Grammar, Science) Composite Score = 24
- GRE (Verbal + Quantitative) Score = 310 (after 8/1/2011)
- GRE (Verbal + Quantitative) Score = 1100 (prior to 8/1/2011)
- Master's Degree from an accredited institution
- Praxis I Pre-professional Skills Test (prior to 9/1/2013)
 - Praxis I Reading: cut score 176
 - Praxis I Mathematics: cut score 175

- Praxis I Writing: cut score 172
- Or Praxis I Combined: summary score 527
- SAT (Critical Reading + Math) Score = 1100
 - Student SAT scores taken on or after 3/1/2016 must be converted to new composite scores in order to determine whether basic competency has been fulfilled.
