Dear Educator Preparation Program Leader(s):

Indiana Code (IC) 20-28-11.5-9, Section 9 (f) requires the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) to provide an annual report to all educator preparation programs (EPPs). Please review the following updates and important reminders:

- Your annual report includes this cover letter and the information specific to your EPP, as posted [here](#) (2025 EPP Comparative Data Matrix).
- HEA 1002 (2025) amended IC 20-28-11.5-9, removing the requirement that school corporations and charter schools provide the results of staff performance evaluations to the department. In addition, it removes the requirement of the department to report the results of staff performance evaluations to teacher preparation programs. As a result, no educator evaluation data is included in this year's report. EPPs are encouraged to employ other methods for gathering data to assess the effectiveness and impact of their program completers.
- A summary of each survey is included on the public matrix, but any results for those with fewer than 10 responses are not included. You will additionally find the non-public survey responses, including any open-ended responses, attached for review. IDOE recommends that EPPs do not post open-ended survey responses online.
- Please note that EPPs are encouraged to supplement IDOE survey results with their own survey data and/or annual survey measures, especially data that is used for accreditation purposes. Legislative requirements are always subject to change, and EPPs should be prepared in the event that IDOE's annual survey collection is no longer legislatively required.
- As a reminder, EPPs are required to post to its respective website all information required under IC 20-28-3-1(1)(g). Please visit IDOE's [Educator Preparation Program Comparative Data and Performance Data webpage](#) and select "Senate Enrolled Act 562" for more details regarding what is required to be posted. Please be sure not to post any data or information that is considered confidential or that would violate the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
